Reception



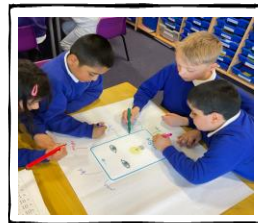
This week we have been learning about the life cycle of a butterfly. We were very excited to watch some of the butterflies emerge from their cocoons. In Maths we have been measuring weight.
