## Year 2



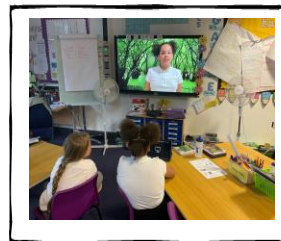
