Our whole school attendance total to date is **94%**

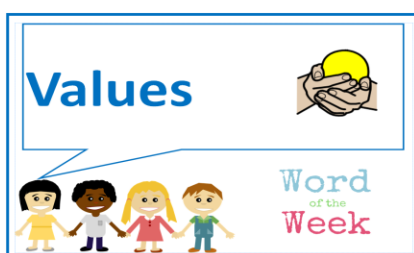

Reception



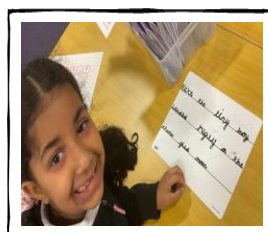

Year 4



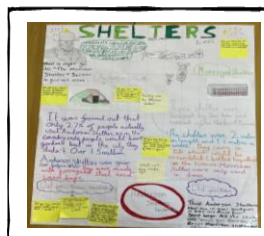
In year 4 we have been writing a recount about our local area trip. In maths we have been using our times table facts to help us with our division work.
