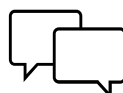

Nursery

Year 1



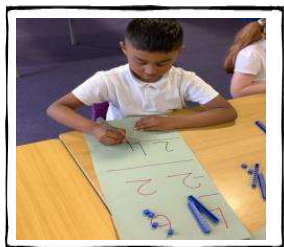
In Sapphire class this week we have been creating WANTED posters for the wolf. We have been using 'and' to make our sentences longer. In Maths we have been subtracting using counters to help us. In Science we began to think about food chains, and which animals are; herbivores, omnivores or carnivores.

Years 1 /2 & 2



This week in Pearl and Topaz class we have been creating WANTED posters for the wolf. We have been working at using 'because' and 'and' in our writing. In maths year 2 children have been subtracting on unmarked number lines and the year 1 children have been subtracting using part whole models.

Year 3



This week in Year 3 we have started a new Roald Dahl text called The Enormous Crocodile. Why don't you ask us all about his devious disguises? Excitingly, we have also learned how to use the column method to solve our subtraction calculations. What mathematical magicians we have been!

Year 4



This week, Year four are writing instructions on how to defeat a gorgon, for English. They used role play to help with the sequencing of their instructions. In Maths, we have been subtracting numbers using column method.

Year 5



This week in Year 5 we went on an exciting trip to Odsall hall in relation to our Tudor topic. We got the opportunity to re-enact the lifestyle of the Tudors.

Year 6



This week, Year 6 completed their balanced argument on whether children should have been evacuated to the countryside, during WW2. In Maths, we have focused on subtraction. We subtracted large numbers, decimal numbers and had to find missing digits in calculations.
