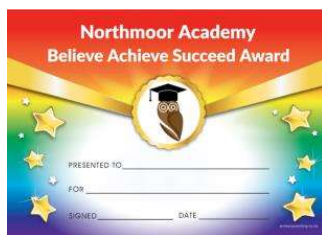

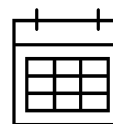
Healthy School

What's been happening this week?



Nursery



In Nursery this week we have been reading the book 'Flashing Fire Engines' and learning all about what firefighters do to help us in an emergency. We have learnt the song 'Five Little Firemen' and the actions.

Reception



This week we have been reading 'ZOG' by Julia Donaldson and Axel Scheffler. We have been making our own dragons using split pins. In Maths we have been creating repeating patterns using natural materials.

Year 1



This week, Sapphire class have been learning about postcards in English. In Maths we have been halving shapes and amounts. In Science we have been thinking about what foods we need to eat to stay healthy. In Geography we have been learning about human features of Australia.

Years 1 /2 & 2



This week, Year 1 have been finding halves of shapes and amounts. Year 2 have been finding fractions of shapes. The children have been learning about the past tense and writing sentences in the past tense.

Year 3



This week, Year 3 have been shocked to discover that the city of Pompeii is being ruined by tourists! We have discussed how we can give top tips to those visiting the ancient city in order to preserve it for years to come! Next week, we will be using all our knowledge to write a persuasive poster! In Maths, we have been exploring 2D shapes and right angles! What a fantastic week!

Year 4



In English, year 4 have been practising their poetry writing skills. We have been looking at rhyming couplets and onomatopoeia to include in our poems. In maths, we are learning about 3D shapes and their properties. We used nets to help to create 3D shapes and identify the number of faces, vertices and edges.

Year 5



This week, in Geography Year 5 have been looking at how to find areas of higher ground using Atlases and Maps. In PSHE we have discussed the importance of showing and recognising empathy.

Year 6



This week, Year 6 have been designing a woven plate. In D&T this term, we are making a tapas placemat, which is linked to our Argentina topic. The incredible designs we have produced have helped us to start weaving.
