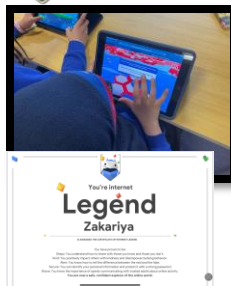
## Word of the Week

# What's been happening this week?

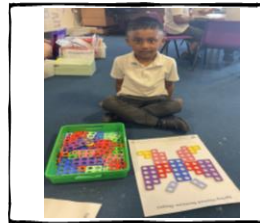


## Nursery



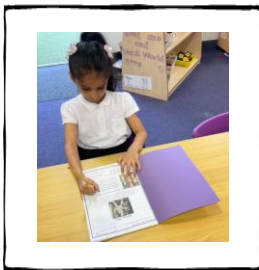

## Year 3



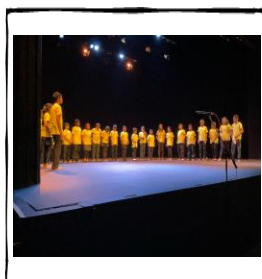
