Reception



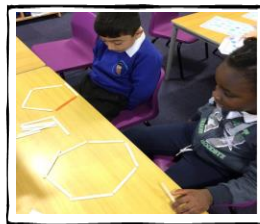
This week in Reception we went on our local area walk. We found lots of things to look at including road signs, post boxes, numbers, mosques, churches and different types of houses.
