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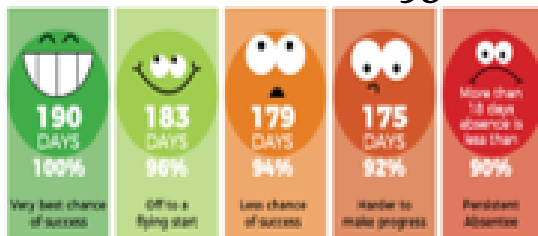
Mrs. Coleman's News

Attendance

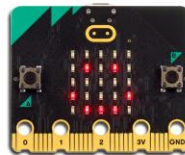
Our school attendance target is 96%

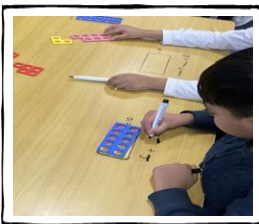


Nursery
