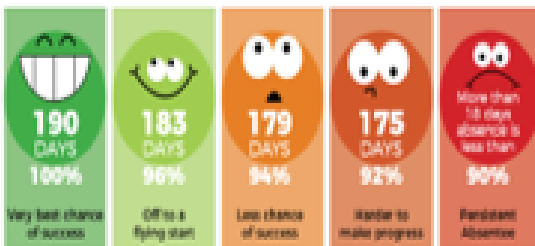
Our school attendance target is 96%

Nursery



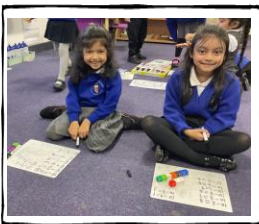

Year 1
