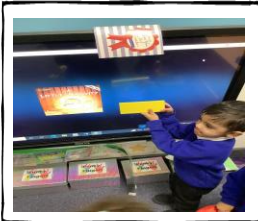
Word of the Week

Year 3



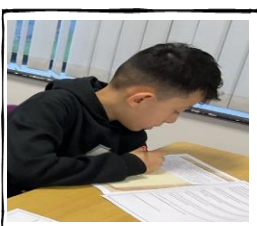
